Responsibility of the Licensed Land Surveyor on signing certificates under Regulations 61 and 97 of the Licensed Land Surveyors Regulations 1959.

This circular is issued to advise all Licensed Land Surveyors that Section 16 of the Licensed Land Surveyors Ordinance 1958 and Regulations 61 and 97 of the Licensed Land Surveyors Regulations 1959 intend to impose a personal liability on the part of a licensed land surveyor to exercise a minimum standard of care as a professional man in any survey work carried out by him. The law, in the aforementioned provisions, require that the licensed land surveyor who signs the field notes and survey plan and the accompanying certificates shall be responsible for their correctness. This being so, any licensed surveyor who had done the survey work, signed the field notes, plans and the accompanying certificates in his own name is legally required to correct any error that was made even though he is no more in the employ of the firm or Licensed Surveyor when such survey was carried out.

2. Licensed Surveyors are therefore reminded of their liability under the said Ordinance (Regulation 31 imposes a duty on them to be conversant with the said Ordinance and any regulations made thereunder etc.) and in view of this to take precautions to see that the survey work carried out by him are correct as required by the Licensed Land Surveyors Regulations 1959.
